Animal: dolphin (though I do love wolves too!)

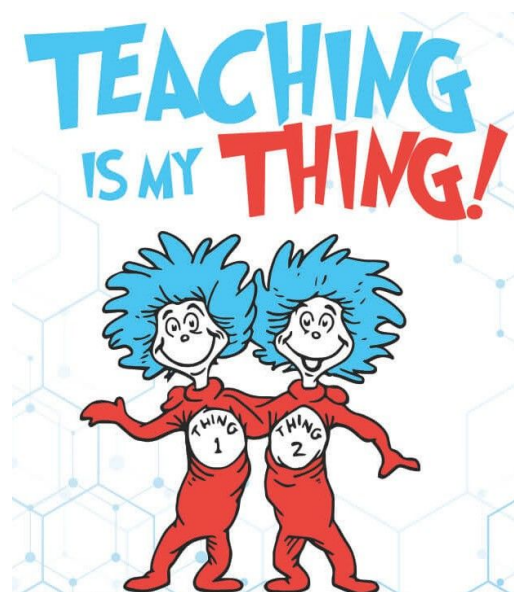
Book: *Oh the Places You'll Go!* by Dr. Seuss
